Google Classroom

This year, all homework and curriculum information for our class will be set using Google Classroom. Our new classroom will be set up at the end of this week and your child will be able to log on using their usual login and password. If you are unsure of these details please do let us know. We will begin to set homework week commencing **18.9.23**.

Homework

All homework for all year groups 1-6 will be set on Friday and will be due in the following Thursday. For the Autumn term, homework will consist of the following:

Subject	Task
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Homework will be set on Maths.co.uk which will be posted on Google Classroom. This will consist of a series of questions which children answer on their devices. Feedback is instant when the homework is complete.• TT Rockstars: 1 session set by the teacher or game per week as a minimum. Feedback will be given to children by class teachers or during key stage assembly.
Spelling/handwriting	Children's spelling words will be sent home and the children will be given a choice of three options to complete in their neatest cursive handwriting in their spelling books which will help with retention of the words and their meaning: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Option 1 – 'Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check'.• Option 2 – Copy out the words three times.• Option 3 – Use the words in a complete sentence.
Reading	Children should enjoy reading every day. Please ensure your child records their reading in their reading record.

Feedback will be posted by teachers weekly on Google Classroom and in your child's spelling book.

Certificates will be sent on Google Classroom for homework:

Green – Being conscientious with your homework - 5 house points

Yellow – We think you could be more conscientious - 2 house points

Red – No homework handed in – 0 house points

We hope this is clear, simple and manageable for all children across the school. If you have any questions or feedback, please do not hesitate to get in touch with your child's class teacher.

PE lessons

Year 6 have PE on a Friday afternoon. Please make sure that they come into school in the correct kit for PE and that they wear their trainers on this day **only**. As the weather becomes colder, please make sure the children have tracksuit bottoms and a jumper for their lessons as they will continue to work outside.
