



National Tutoring Programme strategy statement 2022-23

The National Tutoring Programme (NTP) provides primary and secondary schools with funding to spend on targeted academic support, delivered by trained and experienced tutors and mentors. State-funded schools will receive NTP funding over the course of the 2022 to 2023 academic year to deliver tuition to their pupils. It is intended to cover 60% of the unit cost of tuition, with schools targeting the tutoring offer towards their pupil premium (PP) cohort and making up the remainder of the cost using PP or from other core school budgets.

1) Identified barriers and priorities 2022 -2023

Gaps in pupil's phonetical knowledge.
Below average reading fluency.
Comprehension skills

At Corpus Christi, we have partnered with FFT Tutoring with the Lightning Squad. This is a reading tutoring programme where pupils will work in small groups with a Tutor to improve their reading skills. The tutoring is a blended approach with face-to-face tutoring supported by an online tutoring platform. The tutoring activities are designed and structured to improve reading skills, fluency, comprehension, spellings and phonics. Pupils work through 65 specifically written, engaging illustrated stories.

In the Autumn term, pupils will work with an external tutor for 6 weeks with daily 30-minute tutoring sessions in school. Research has demonstrated that pupils using 'Tutoring with the Lightning Squad' make learning gains of between 3 – 5 months in reading attainment.
