**Mark 1:16-20**

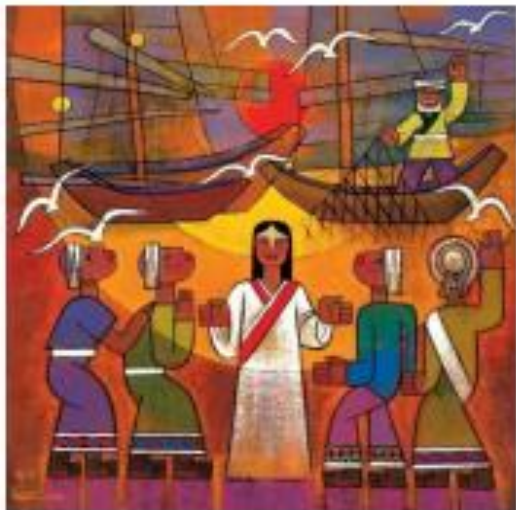

# WATER SAFETY

Following an incident involving children and the river Thames recently we are sharing important information;

Given the current weather conditions and the likelihood of further cold spells, we are asking parents to remind their children, that going into the river or on ice is extremely dangerous. [Cold water shock](#), a primary precursor to drowning, can occur in water temperatures below 15°C. The River Thames typically drops to between 3°C and 9°C (37°F – 48°F) during January and February. If someone experiences cold water shock, they should float on their back rather than attempting to swim.

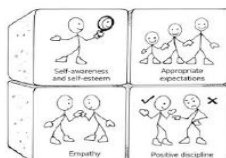
## The Parenting Puzzle
