Dear parents/carers,

What another busy week we have had! Our Year 6 children spent a day at their new secondary schools on Wednesday and all our children in school moved to their new teacher and classroom. An exciting time for everyone!

St Pius class held their Class Service this morning and it was absolutely beautiful. They reminded us how special they are and prayed for their families. We have also been wowed by Year 3 in their Ukulele concert, Year 5 & 6's accomplished piano playing and the amazing orchestra. Rock Steady have also entertained us this afternoon. What a very talented school of children we have!

Year 2 have visited the Lookout Discovery Centre today and have returned full of tales of what they have learned about 'Microhabitats'.

I met for the last time with our Class Friends yesterday. I am so very grateful to all of you who have volunteered to do this role. It is so important to have this means of communication. Overwhelmingly, there was positive feedback and I am of course, delighted that so many of you are very happy with what is happening at Corpus Christi.

A large part of the discussion concerned the Governor's Fund. There appears to be scepticism about why we are promoting this. All Voluntary Aided (Faith) schools have this as the Governing Body is legally required to fund 10% of all building and maintenance work in Faith schools. Community schools rely on Government budgets.

We have always had a Governor's Fund which some families have regularly paid into but we are having a big 'push' now because we have academised and have new bank accounts. The question was asked, what is the difference between the PTA and the Governor's Fund? I would say that the Fund contributes to vital but less obvious projects in the school, whereas the PTA, supported by you all at our different events, are able to fund exciting things directly for the children. However, the more money that the Governor's Fund receives, the more we will generally be able to do.

This weeks collective worship was centred around the celebration of St Peter and St Paul. Even though they were very different people with different talents, Jesus called both of them to do extraordinary things. Peter was a rugged fisherman. He was impulsive, he made mistakes, and he even denied knowing Jesus when things got tough. But Peter loved Jesus with all his heart. Jesus chose him to be the "rock." Paul was highly educated, strict, and travelled everywhere. At first, he didn't even like Christians! But after a dramatic encounter with Jesus on the road to Damascus, he changed completely. He travelled thousands of miles to preach and wrote letters that we still read in church today.
