Writing: Setting description, letters, newspaper article, diary writing

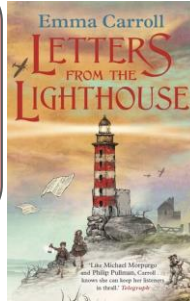
Spelling: Statutory Words
